


The Hooley on Kamm's Corners™ Second Saturday in May

This free family event takes place on the second Saturday of May each year. More than 90 vendors participate, including local businesses, national chains, and some of Cleveland's finest artists. The Pipes and Drums of the Cleveland Police perform at the opening ceremonies. The main stage at Rocky River Drive features a blend of local Celtic music as well as contemporary American music. A family entertainment area keeps kids occupied with Irish dancers, performances by local school children, games, art, and more. Open to all, it is a day of music, art, food, and family fun provided with assistance from Councilman Martin J. Keane and the City of Cleveland.

Kamm's Corners Farmers Market Every Sunday, June - October

Open every Sunday from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. June through October, the market offers fresh produce and locally made products from more than 20 vendors. But this farmers market offers much more than food. It offers free live performances from local musicians, cooking demonstrations from award-winning culinary masters, and local artisan showcases. The market takes place in the municipal parking lot at West 168th and Lorain Avenue. It is supported by several community businesses and organizations.



Asphalt Cinema Third Friday - June, July & August

An evening of music, art, dancing, games, and prizes ends under the stars with a family friendly movie on the third Fridays of the summer months at Impett Park. A master facilitator engages the children in music, singing, and dancing from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. At the same time, local merchants offer creative games, activities, and artistic opportunities to draw a character from the featured film or color a T-shirt. Local organizations provide the concessions. At dusk, a movie is shown on a large screen against a backdrop of tall trees to families on lawn chairs and blankets.
